Performances are in the evening. Book your tickets at the office early as seating will be limited.


Week 9 - Conservation Week: 14 - 22 September.

LITERACY



In the first half of this term we will focus on Fairy Tales which will link to our school production. We will write creatively and with lots of imagination. In the second half of the term our writing will be linked in with science through Conservation Week inquiry. When we start this inquiry our writing will be based on experiences outside the classroom as much as possible so they have hands on experiences to write about.

LIBRARY & READING

Students will visit the library and exchange books every **Tuesday**. On Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday children will bring home readers. Please listen to them read and sign the reading log. Every page they fill gets them a prize from the prize box. Children really look forward to this.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics we will be looking at Measurement (length, area, weight, temperature, volume). The younger ones will do this with non-standard units eg measuring in steps, with blocks, or hands. Older children will be using rulers and looking at centimetres and metres. We will also be looking at shapes. The underlying theme of number will go throughout the whole term.

SPORT

In PE and sport, we will focus on Large Ball Skills; passing, throwing and catching, and teamwork. Jordan from Sport Tasman will be coming out to teach specific skills and drills to develop movement and coordination every **Friday**. The Arts (drama, singing, dancing, stage performance and art) will be based around the school production, Alice in Wonderland. While Nikau students do not have speaking roles they will be involved as the Queen's soldiers. We are looking forward to making costumes and joining in rehearsals.

MAORI

In Maori we will focus on numbers, both learning the names of them and adding numbers together (up to 12).
